Well, it's been a while since Clausura for week-end #72. That week-end meant so much to me. When we left, my wife Sally and I couldn't stop talking about the experiences we had, the wonderful staff, the tear-jerking Palanca, the eye-opening Rollos, the overall good that came out of such a week-end, and the ways we could continue to participate, both at new week-ends and as members of an ever-growing 4th Day community. We are coming up on a year now, since driving away from Lake Sharon. At first, we beat feet to Reunions, and Ultreya meetings. We made darn sure to attend staff training, and I was privileged to staff as a Table Leader on week-end #74, then Sally was called and served as a Food Cha for week-end #75.

But, in the interim, a flurry of things happened. Jobs, hobbies, and \$4/gallon gas, raided our wallets, sapped our strength and devoured our week-ends, forcing us to miss Ultreyas and disabling our capability <u>and</u> ability to make time for any Reunion trips. We don't live in close proximity to the vast majority of our Via de Cristo family, so we are often separated by the sparse times we get to see each other.

At times, I have caught myself sitting at the dining room table with my Pilgrim's Guide, quietly sighing like an Alzheimer's victim, as I struggle to remember names of the staff that I fondly revered from week-end #72, and now, pathetically, cannot grasp. We used to laugh about my ability to "get lost in closet" while driving to Denton, missing exits and making wrong turns. Now, I frantically search the recesses of my mind trying to remember the path from Wichita Falls to Lake Sharon, brushing a tear aside, almost feeling like we've forgotten something much more important.

But, we haven't. The little desk plate by my phone at work evokes Martin Luther's reminder, "It is the duty of every Christian to be Christ to his neighbor" and governs every part of my day. I cannot fathom the number of times it has directly influenced all with whom I come in contact. My hobby is theatre. Over the year, I have poured hours into rehearsals; hours that I thought could have been better spent in direct service to the Lord. But, I learned that laughter, the laughter I provided, truly was the best medicine for hundreds who saw our shows.

I also serve as a volunteer in our local Hospice-I don't evangelize, but I've been told just being there as a new partner in each patient's journey is a blessing, to the patients, their families, as well as to me. Sally works in the local school district and has taken to repairing and giving clothes to her students in need. She has told me how seeing the them preen themselves in their "new" clothes, and often hearing their thanks, or seeing their non-verbal gratitude, makes her heart melt.

I sn't that what the 4th day is all about? I t's not about the celebrities you remember from your week-end, the number of week-end events, or which Rollo you get to give, or Reunions, or Ultreyas, or placemats (although Faith in Wichita Falls makes the best!). I t's about being Christ to your neighbor all day on that 4th day!!
