Ways to Give to LVDCNT

Nearly all of LVDCNT's income comes from you—the 4th Day. Let me discuss the most common opportunities to give to LVDCNT.

- 1. Sponsor a participant. The current cost is \$165 per participant, but going up to \$190 in the near future. If you can't cover the entire cost it is perfectly OK to pay only a portion and seek additional help from your small group, ultreya, or the Secretariat.
- 2. Give an offering at Weekend Closura services. This can be done in person or via the means discussed below.

- Give an offering at Grand Ultreyas. This can also be done in person or via the means discussed below.
- 4. Give a gift at any time.
- 5. Direct all or a portion of your Thrivent Choice dollars to us.
- 6. Apply for a Thrivent Action Team card.

I want to first focus on Thrivent, as I think this may be an untapped resource for us. If you are a Thrivent member you have access to both Thrivent Choice dollars and Thrivent Action Team cards. Thrivent Choice allows you to direct money to the nonprofit of your choice (hopefully LVDCNT). Thrivent Action Team cards are \$250 cash cards you can apply for to support a fundraising activity or a service active that supports a nonprofit. Instructions on how to do either of these are not complicated, but a little much to try to explain here. But if you would like to pursue either option I would be glad to speak with you and walk you through the process.

So how can you get the money to LVDCNT? Other than in person, there are three primary ways to give. If you are sponsoring a participant, send a check along with the registration paperwork to the Registrar (currently Sharon Bartells). Checks for other offerings or gifts can be sent to Jerry Gray at 2433 Timber Ridge Lane, Flower Mound, TX 75028. All checks should be made out to LVDCNT. The easiest way for you to give may be electronically via our website, https://www.vdcnorthtexas.org.

The "Donate Now" tab is orange and is at the top far right of the webpage. We currently use PayPal to collect the donations. The electronic process is very straight forward, but if you have any questions call Jerry Gray at 972-333-5614.
