As I write I am on a plane returning from the National Secretariat meeting which was held this year in the Minneapolis / St Paul area. It was a spiritual weekend filled with the presence of God's Holy Spirit living amAong us.

You should be able to recognize Via de Cristo if you leave here and go to North Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, Tennessee or Florida but it is only possible when those essential pieces are all in place.

Via de Cristo is not for everyone and we are not out to "Via de Cristo ize" the world but we do want our movement to remain Via de Cristo so we can be a welcome home to those who come to us from Michigan, Arizona, Ohio, Colorado, Georgia or California.

Let us continue in the traditions we have built in our soon to be 81 weekends by following the essentials and adding the flavor of who we are without detracting from what Via de Cristo is meant to be. Let us be an open, welcoming, recognizable Via de Cristo family of God. We were given the elements for a renewal movement which have worked for over 50 years; we do not need to change a thing.
