A MESSAGE FROM THE LAY DIRECTOR

Grace and Peace to you from God our Father and from His Son, Jesus Christ who is our shepherd.

When I think of Via de Cristo I am surrounded by the images of sheep and shepherds. In John 21, Jesus three times asks Peter "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" When Peter replies affirmatively, Jesus tells Peter each time to feed his lambs, feed his sheep. This is the same call we, as the 4th Day, are to answer. We are to feed Jesus' sheep. NEWS FROM THE PRE-WEEKEND TEAM

Greetings to the 4th Day Community from your Pre-Weekend Representative, on behalf of the Pre-Weekend Team!

What, you may ask, is the Pre-Weekend Team and what is its function? Glad you asked! This is a new group assembled this year, of people from around this Secretariat's region who share my interest in getting the word out about Via de Cristo and in assisting the 4th Day with other Pre-Weekend functions as needed.

Basically, the Pre-Weekend functions are (1) public relations, (2) recruiting, and (3) Sponsor awareness.

Public relations: This will consist of providing general information about Via de Cristo to any congregation in our area which either requests it or is otherwise receptive to it. In this regard, we have a couple of different types of tri-fold brochures available, and we also have a supply of an excellent DVD produced by the National Lutheran Secretariat entitled "*Is Christ Calling You.*" It is 12 minutes long, is a very nice, up-to-date presentation about what Via de Cristo is, and includes a number of testimonials. Note that <u>each member</u> of the Pre-Weekend Team now <u>has a copy</u> of the DVD, and is available to either come to your group and show it, or to make arrangements to lend it out to you. We would love to have speaking engagements during Sunday School hours or similar times, and would like to show the DVD then!

<u>Recruiting</u>: I am not ashamed to use the word "recruiting" when I speak of the <u>extra</u> efforts which we should all be considering in order to introduce our Christian friends to the concept of Via de Cristo. Remember that feeling that came welling up from inside you at the end of your Weekend, when you wanted everyone you love to experience what you had experienced? We want to rekindle that enthusiasm and give you the necessary tools and guidance to use that enthusiasm to share the Via de Cristo experience with others!

Sponsor Awareness: The well-informed Sponsors should be careful and prayerful in identifying potential participants, because (1) they should be satisfied that the participants meet the suggested criteria for attendance at a Weekend, and (2) they should be sure that they (the Sponsors) are committed to see to their candidate's 4th Day experience through small groups and Ultreya activities. A good resource for potential Sponsors to review is page 2 of the application form (available on the web site), because it contains a concise statement of these two items. More resources and information are available; just contact any member of the Pre-Weekend Team.

The Pre-Weekend Team had its first "small group" meeting at the May Grand Ultreya, and is ready to assist you with any of your Pre-Weekend needs or ideas. Please feel free to contact either me or any of the other Team members:
